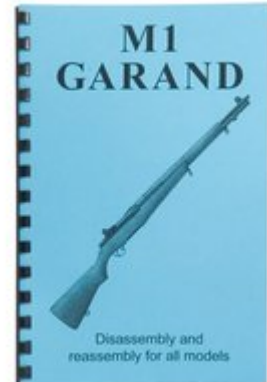

Safety Instructions

Introduction
