One receiver can utilize numerous barrels of varying length, material, and caliber. The CQBMWS upper receiver has 19.25" of uninterrupted picatinny rail on the 12 o'clock position. 9" of picatinny rail on 3 and 9 o'clock positions with 7" of rail at the 6 o'clock position. MWS® barrels utilize a low profile gas block and straight gas tube. They possess proprietary coating and are cryogenically treated for long term durability. The LM308MWS lower receiver features LMT's EDM machined two-stage trigger, ambidextrous magazine release and safety selector, endplate with QD swivel point, LMT® ergonomic textured grip, and SOPMOD stock. As with all LMT® lower receivers, the extension tube is coated with dry film lubricant. This weapon system comes with one magazine, owner's manual, flip-up front and rear sights, 2 heavy duty push button swivels, and 3 rail panels.
