Hook and loop flaps teamed with an adjustable webbing strap secure the pistol. Reinforced webbing adjusts to fit a riggers, pistol, or duty belt with a quick-release buckle for rapid removal. The leg harnesses are elastic and webbing, and the straps are also coupled with quick-release buckles. Mount this holster to your hip for quick access to your pistol. Trust that your defense is just inches away.
