The bullet guide is provided with radial clearance to allow the case and bullet guide to align perfectly with the bullet seater screw. The floating bullet guide is reversible, simply unthread guide and re-install to allow seating and crimping simultaneously, an exclusive feature to Lee. This bullet seating die proves accuracy doesn't have to cost a lot.
