The MXP has a CNC aluminum housing and QP nitride 4140 PH steel pin held in place with existing AR-15 lower kit parts. 5. Slide the MXP extension onto the magazine until it clicks into place, indicating secure attachment.
6. Verify that the extension is firmly attached by gently tugging on it.

Usage

- Load the magazine extension according to the capacity specifications:
 - +5 rounds on Gen M3 PMAG 10, 20, 30, and TMAG models.
 - +6 rounds on PMAG 40.
- Always ensure the magazine is seated properly in the firearm before use.
- Follow all safety practices when handling firearms.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the MXP Magazine Extension in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of the product in regular household waste.
