Switch From Percussion To Cartridge By Changing Cylinders

Six-round conversion cylinder converts steel frame, cap and ball revolvers to modern centerfire. Patterned after an original Remington design for a drop-in fit. Cylinder and back plate fit together without screws. To reload, just drop the cylinder, pull the plate off and dump the fired cases. Use in steel frame guns only, with black powder equivalent loads. No FFL required to purchase. Models for .44 caliber, 1858 Remington Italian replicas, Uberti and Ruger® Old Army™ are chambered for the .45 Colt cartridge. Your bore should be slugged and verified to be capable of running a .451-452" diameter projectile by a qualified gunsmith. This is for STEEL frame 44 cal.only. NOT FOR BRASS FRAME REVOLVERS. For use with 'cowboy' loads only, nothing to exceed 750 to 800 ft. per second black powder loads up to 34 grains of FFG black powder or equivalent, for STEEL frame guns ONLY.

Safety Instruction Guide for REVOLVER CARTRIDGE CONVERSION CYLINDER

Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the REVOLVER CARTRIDGE CONVERSION CYLINDER by Taylors and Co. This product is designed to convert steel frame cap and ball revolvers to modern centerfire. It is important to understand how to use this product safely and effectively. This guide provides essential safety instructions and information in compliance with the EU General Product Safety Regulation (GPSR).

General Safety Guidelines

- Always handle firearms with care and respect. Treat every firearm as if it is loaded.
- Ensure that you are using this conversion cylinder with steel frame revolvers only. Do not use it with brass frame revolvers.
- Only use black powder equivalent loads. Do not exceed 750 to 800 feet per second.
- Check that your bore is slugged and verified by a qualified gunsmith to be capable of handling a .451452" diameter projectile.
- Keep this product out of reach of children and unauthorized users.
- Report any unsafe products or accidents to the relevant authorities.
- Stay updated on recall information via the EU Safety Gate platform.

Specific Safety Precautions for Use

- **Age Restrictions:** This product is not intended for use by individuals under the age of 18.
- **Hazard Identification:**
 - Risk of injury if used improperly or with incompatible firearms.
 - Risk of damage to the firearm if not fitted correctly.
- **Avoiding Hazards:**
 - Ensure proper fitting to the base pin. If necessary, seek assistance from a qualified gunsmith.

Instructions for Installation and Usage
