Set stoning angle by counting "clicks" specified to raise or lower elevator and stoning guide. Lock guide, place stone on both roller and hammer or trigger/sear, and stone as normal. Easily adjustable to allow variations in stoning angle for exact, desired trigger pull weight. Same tool Ron Power uses in his own shop. Complete with one adapter and very detailed instructions written by Ron. You will also need a #10 Machinist's Clamp and 6"x½"x½" stones (listed elsewhere). ab

Introduction

- Lock the guide in place once the desired angle is achieved.

4. Stoning Process

- Place the stone on both the roller and hammer or trigger/sear.
- Proceed with the stoning process as normal, ensuring to maintain a steady hand and focus.

5. PostUse Care

- Once stoning is complete, carefully remove the firearm and all components from the fixture.
- Clean the fixture and store it in a safe location.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any damaged components in accordance with local waste disposal regulations.
- Do not dispose of the fixture or its components in household waste. Instead, contact your local waste management facility for proper disposal methods.
