# Safety Instruction Guide for BORE CLEANING FOAM (AEROSOL)

## Introduction

Thank you for choosing BORE CLEANING FOAM (AEROSOL) by GENERAL NANO PROTECTION. This guide provides essential safety instructions to ensure the safe and effective use of this product. Please read this guide carefully before using the product.

## General Safety Guidelines

- Hold the canister upright, approximately 1520 cm away from the surface to be cleaned.
- Press the nozzle to release the foam onto the bore of the firearm.
- Allow the foam to sit for the recommended time as indicated on the label.

### 3. PostApplication:

- Wipe away any excess foam with a clean cloth.
- Ensure the firearm is dry before using it again.

## Disposal Instructions

- Do not dispose of the product in household waste.
- Follow local regulations for aerosol disposal.
- If the canister is empty, recycle it according to your local recycling guidelines.
- If the canister is not empty, take it to a designated hazardous waste collection site.
