This sporting weapon was developed by Brownells Austria especially for the IPSC area PCC. The following components are used: barrel (16 inch) and bolt is from CMMG in the Radial Delayed Blowback System (see video), the lower part is also from CMMG and designed for Glock magazines, the upper part is from Aero Precision with extra large ejection window for 9mm, The trigger and the small parts are from BCM, the rear stock from Double Star ACE Lite, the Handguard from Wrenchman in the length 15.5 inches and has an M-Lock system, the through loading lever is from Radian Weapons, the compensator from VG6 Precision, the buffer is from Brownells in the conception Rifle, a JP Tuning Buffer Spring rounds everything. A 10 shot magazine is supplied with the sporting gun. This sport weapon has an expert opinion on category B.

Brownells RD9 Austria Safety Instruction Guide

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the Brownells RD9 Austria. This sporting weapon has been specially developed for the IPSC area PCC. It is essential to follow safety guidelines to ensure safe and effective use. This guide provides important safety instructions and usage information in compliance with the EU General Product Safety Regulation (GPSR).

General Safety Guidelines

- Always treat the firearm as if it is loaded.
- Keep the muzzle pointed in a safe direction at all times.

 - Attach the rear stock from Double Star ACE Lite.
3. **Check Magazine Compatibility:** Ensure that the magazine used is compatible with Glock magazines as specified.
4. **Final Inspection:** Conduct a final inspection to ensure all parts are correctly assembled and secure.

Usage

1. **Loading the Firearm:**
 - Use the provided 10shot magazine to load the firearm.
 - Ensure the firearm is pointed in a safe direction while loading.
2. **Firing:**
 - Take a stable shooting stance and aim at the target.
