Safety Instruction Guide for S.P.S. Falcon Uno

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the S.P.S. Falcon Uno, a semiautomatic pistol designed for classic division shooting. This guide provides essential safety instructions and guidelines to ensure safe and effective use of your firearm. Please read this document carefully before using the product.
