MDT TIMBR Core Laminate Kit Safety Instructions

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the MDT TIMBR Core Laminate Kit. This rifle stock combines beauty and performance, crafted from solid walnut with a precisionengineered aluminum microchassis. To ensure safe and effective use of your product, please read this safety instruction guide carefully.

- Always use the integrated sling studs to safely attach bipods or carry straps.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Preparation

- Gather all necessary tools, including a torque wrench.
- Ensure you are in a welllit and safe area for installation.

2. Installation of the Stock

- Remove the existing stock from your rifle, ensuring it is unloaded.
- Align the action of your rifle with the Vblock bedding system of the TIMBR Core stock.
- Secure the action into place by following these steps:
 - Position the action into the stock.
 - Use the torque wrench to tighten the screws to the manufacturer's specifications.
- Doublecheck that the action is firmly secured without any movement.

3. Adjusting Length of Pull (LOP)

- If needed, adjust the LOP spacers according to your preference.
- Ensure that all spacers are securely fastened.

4. Using the Stock

- Familiarize yourself with the grip angles and ergonomics for optimal comfort.
- When ready to shoot, ensure a proper stance and grip on the rifle.
- Always be aware of your surroundings and ensure a clear line of sight before firing.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the product in accordance with local regulations regarding wood and aluminum materials.
- If the stock is damaged beyond repair, consider recycling the materials where applicable.
